Making Impressions

Tucked onto the fourth floor of a Boylston Street building, the **St. George Gallery** is bright and unfettered. Its owner, artist William St. George, is known for his vivid outdoor depictions of Boston and other regions of New England. In the exhibition space, massive seascapes hang next to stylized portraits (some of celebrities, some not), and many portrayals of horses, a favorite subject of St. George. Filled with fat brushstrokes, his work often combines oil paint with acrylics and demonstrates a passion for color and movement.—LD
